

HB 3693 Compliance Report

The City of Sealy complies with the requirements of HB 3693 (Government Code § 2265.001(b)) by compiling and posting the total metered amounts of electricity, water, and natural gas consumed by the city and the aggregate cost for those utility services. Please note:

- The City of Sealy purchases electricity from Cavallo Energy Texas, LLC. The company markets and supplies the Texas General Land Office State Power Program. It is designed specifically to meet the needs and satisfy the energy procurement objectives of public sector consumers, such as independent school districts, cities, counties, state agencies, hospital districts, colleges and universities, and taxing entities.
- The City of Sealy is a municipal supplier of water and natural gas services. As a self-supplier, the city does not expend municipal funds in providing these services for its own operational needs.
